## ACADEMIC CREDITS

As UF in Prague is a UF-sponsored program, credits from courses taken can satisfy major, minor, and university requirements with prior approval. UF GPA credit will be granted for the courses taken with UF faculty. Transfer credit will be earned for any courses taken at Anglo-American University, our Prague host.

## HOUSING

Students stay in a residence hall in a desirable section of Prague. Dorm is centrally located, allowing easy access to stores, restaurants and city transit. Basic amenities are available (laundry, mini-kitchen, internet, light housekeeping); ATM & printing inside dorm.

## **FEES DUE UPON APPLICATION:**

A \$350 nonrefundable deposit toward the total cost of the program is required at the time of application. The remaining fees are due no later than 45 days prior to departure. If you receive financial aid, you can defer payment until it disburses. Deferral decisions will be based on the amount of aid to be received.

### ***Not Included in the program fees:***

Round-trip airfare, meals, additional personal travel and personal expenses.
