Advanced Hungarian

This course is for students with advance knowledge of Hungarian grammar and vocabulary and with some experience Hungarian language (they've already taken HNG 1130 and/or 1131 or spent longer time in Hungary or learned the language from their parents) but couldn't practice the language and extend their vocabulary recently.

This course focuses on classical and contemporary Hungarian history, literature, music, and art. In this class we practice Hungarian grammar through the Hungarian history and literature. We use short readings, blogs, movies, and students need to tell the stories with their own words, or they need to write down the stories what they heard from their classmates. Students will improve their listening skills as well their spelling/grammar skills. Learning about Hungarian culture (from the beginning to recent days) can give a new perspective to all students.

Other goals for the semester: using all Hungarian conjugations (present definite/indefinite; past definite/indefinite; imperative conditional; conditional definite/indefinite) and be able to communicate in Hungarian with confidence.
