Students will read articles and watch videos about Afrobubblegum, identify characteristic words and discuss in pairs their impressions.

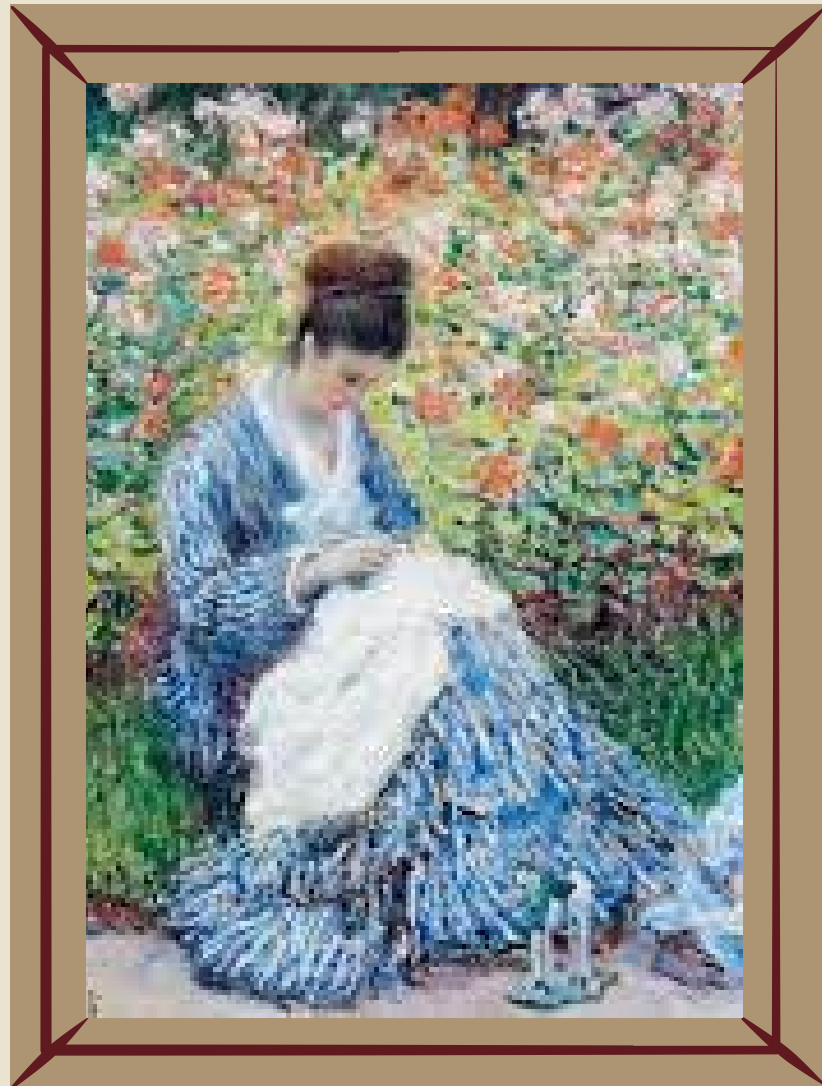
Students will write and present a final project on a word created to express an idea in the Sciences or Politics or any domain of their liking, including the Arts.

- Write and present in French a paper highlighting a word specific to a domain.



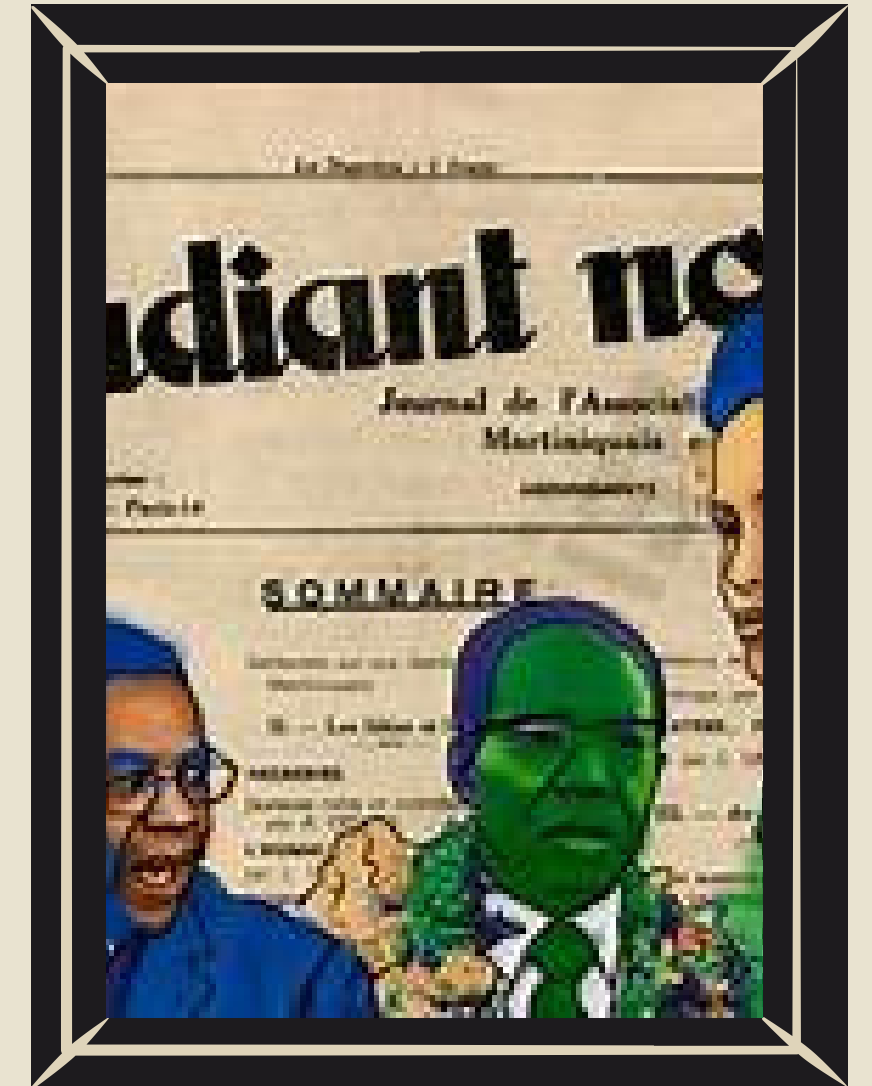
